Making a Gift in your Will

A gift in your will, of any size, acknowledges the importance Loreto Toorak has played in your life and your hope that the School continues to thrive and enrich the lives of other girls.

Unencumbered gifts allow Loreto Toorak to grow its Endowment Fund; a fund dedicated to "Give a Girl a Dream", providing bursaries and ensuring we maintain the breadth of students that define our School and its accessibility to the wider community.

Types of Bequests

- A residual bequest the remainder of the estate after all legacies and costs
- A pecuniary bequest a specific sum
- A percentage of an estate
- Gifts in kind real estate, artwork, share portfolio

Codicil

If you already have a will, you may simply add a codicil to include Loreto Toorak; a straightforward and inexpensive process.

Legal Assistance

We encourage you to seek independent legal or financial advice when preparing or updating your will. It is important that you discuss your will and codicil with your family and ensure they understand and support your decision. The correct wording for including the School in your will is Loreto Mandeville Hall Toorak Limited.



THE SILK SOCIETY




In recognition of your support, you will be invited to be a part of the Silk Society, named in honour of the silk damask in the Reception Room of Mandeville Hall.
